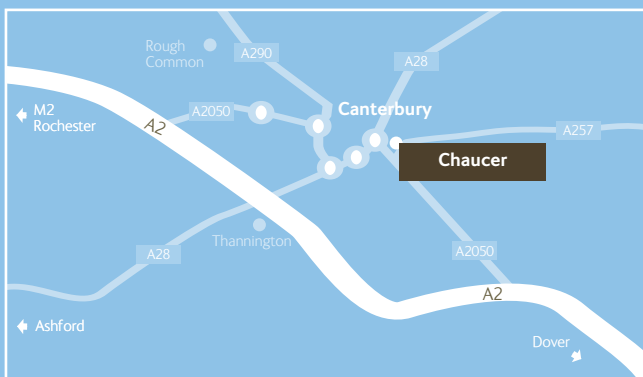

How to find us

Leave the M2 at junction 7. Follow the slip road up to a roundabout and get onto the A2 to Canterbury. Leave the A2 after approx 5 miles and follow the signs to Canterbury. After 1 mile, go straight over the first roundabout onto Rheims Way. At the next roundabout, turn right. At the next two roundabouts go straight over, then get into the right hand lane as you approach the next roundabout and turn right into the New Dover Road (A2055). Turn 1st left for the Chaucer Hotel car park. If you miss this turning, take the next left and then left again into Ivy lane and the car park is at the end of this road on your left.

Nearest airport: Gatwick Airport (67 miles)
